Dear Sir / Madam,

I am writing on behalf of my team to express our interest to apply for the Travel4Youths grants as a student organization namely Psychosocial Welfare at the University of Dar es salaam. For it has been our long ambition to travel to a rural Arusha region to learn on Maasai culture, prove true or wrong the issues said to happen there and find ways to help these communities.

Psychosocial Welfare, is an organization with passionate, activists and highly committed 400 undergraduate students from Psychology, social work, early childhood and special education degree programs from three universities namely University of Dar es salaam (UDSM), Institute of Social Work (ISW) and University of Dodoma (UDOM) all based on Tanzania. Aiming to learn practically and provide psychosocial supports to all vulnerable groups.

Some of Maasai people in rural Arusha region are said to secretly conduct female genital mutilation (FGM) and they are said to have gender based violence. With the help of our social and psychology knowledge, we wish to visit some of Maasai households to find out the truth, learn some of their cultures and finding a means to assist them.

To achieve this travel, we are consequently requesting a total of USD 500 for transport and accommodation, where only five 5 representatives will be selected and the expenditure will read as follows; a bus fare from Dar es salaam to Arusha rural, for one individual is USD 22 and the return journey costs USD 22. A total transport fee for five 5 students is USD 220. On the stipends for meals and accommodation for each student counts USD 9 per day and USD 45 for five days expected to be spent in the field, a total stipends cost for all five students and for five days is USD 225. Then USD 5 will be for stationeries.

Getting this grant is an opportunity, we would love to dedicate ourselves wholeheartedly, for it is the program looking forward to contribute to youths' learnings, we hope our travel program will be successful through the Travel4youths grants.
